WARM WELCOME TO BISHOP ELECT FINTAN GAVIN

I am delighted that Pope Francis has appointed Fr. Fintan Gavin as the new Bishop of Cork and Ross. While I have never met him, I am very impressed with his C.V. Endowed with excellent academic and administrative skills, what I like most about him is his pastoral work record. The Church needs pastors!

He has worked as a teacher and school chaplain in Dublin. While doing a doctorate at the Gregorian University in Rome, he worked at the soup kitchen of the Sant'Egidio Community, a movement of lay people based on prayer, solidarity, ecumenism, dialogue and a practical love of preference for the poor. He worked with university students in spiritual accompaniment. He served one summer in Buenos Aires, Argentina, with a group of Italian students on a mission experience. While serving in St. Andrews Parish, Westland Row, Dublin, he was involved with 'Second Chance Saturday', a vigil Mass for those who had drifted from Church that invites and encourages people to give their faith a second chance. He has served as chaplain to Dublin Diocesan Children's Pilgrimage to Lourdes. He has worked as Music Director over the last nine years with the Gospel Choir in Our Lady of Victories Parish in Ballymun. The list goes on.

I invite all parishioners to join in prayer for him, that he may be a shepherd to us in Cork and Ross, following the example of the Good Shepherd.
