KINSALE PARISH SAFEGUARDING

As a constituent member of the Catholic Church in Ireland, we recognise and uphold the dignity and rights of all children, are committed to ensuring their safety and well-being, and will work in partnership with parents/guardians to do this. We recognise each child as a gift from God, and we value and encourage the participation of children in all activities that enhance their spiritual, physical, emotional, intellectual and social development.

All Church personnel (including clergy, religious, staff, volunteers and any other Church personnel) have a responsibility to safeguard children through promoting their welfare, health and development in a safe and caring environment that supports their best interests and prevents abuse.

Kinsale has three Parish Safeguarding Representatives: Angela O'Sullivan, Helen Kiely and John Thuillier who meet regularly with Fr. Robert. Together, they promote child and vulnerable adult safeguarding by:

- Raising awareness of what safeguarding is;
- Disseminating information regarding the standards and guidance, and circulating this information widely;
- Ensuring Church activities are provided in a way that ensures the safety and well-being of the children and vulnerable adults involved;
- Ensuring that the contact details of the Designated Liaison Person, Gardaí and Tusla are widely publicised;
- Upholding the Seven Standards in practice and behaviour
 1. *Creating and Maintaining Safe Environments*
 2. *Procedures for Responding to Child Protection Suspicions, Concerns, Knowledge or Allegations*
 3. *Care and Support for the Complainant*
 4. *Care and Management of the Respondent*
 5. *Training and Support for Keeping Children Safe*
 6. *Communicating the Church's Safeguarding Message*
 7. *Quality Assuring Compliance with the Standards.*

THE GOOD NEWS OF JESUS – GREAT NEWS IN KINSALE

Divine Renovation, established in Canada by Fr. James Mallon which aims to bring our Church from MAINTENANCE TO MISSION has started in our Parish. Of course the Canadian experience will be different to Kinsale, but the overall message is clear, we need to move from MAINTENANCE TO MISSION, otherwise our Church will continue to decline.

Dr. Anne Francis, from Innishannon Parish, who works in Faith Formation and helps in the preparation for lay ministry, is leading us on an 8 week course to enable us to better understand what it is to be a follower of Christ in our Parish today, how to live out the teachings of Christ and how to PASS ON THE FAITH TO THE NEXT GENERATION.

We have met in the Friary Centre on the past two Sundays from 7.30 to 9.30pm. Over 50 people have already attended. The reaction has been very encouraging. Some typical responses include: *"it is great to talk openly about our faith"*, *"we share our hopes and concerns with fellow parishioners"*, *"we place ourselves in the hands of the Holy Spirit for guidance"*, *"we hope this course will enable us to bring ourselves, our children and our Parish into discipleship with Christ"*.
