ANNIVERSARY OF POPE FRANCIS

On 13 March 2020, his Holiness Pope Francis marks the 7th anniversary of his election by the papal conclave as Bishop of Rome and leader of the Catholic Church.

Pope Francis was born Jorge Mario Bergoglio in Buenos Aires, Argentina in 1936 and is the first Jesuit pope, the first from the Americas and the first from the Southern Hemisphere. He was ordained a Catholic priest in 1969 and became the Archbishop of Buenos Aires in 1998. He was made a cardinal in 2001 by Pope John Paul II. Following his election on 13 March 2013, he was inaugurated on 19 March 2013 and chose Francis as his papal name in honour of Saint Francis of Assisi.
