MISSION SUNDAY

This weekend we celebrate Mission Sunday. We are being asked to remember our missionaries all over the world, and to remember that each one of us, followers of Jesus, are asked to be missionaries and make his name known wherever we are. Mission Sunday is about making Jesus known. Our Church does not have a message of its own; it is the message of Jesus that has a Church - the community of believers.

Ireland has a proud history of missionaries going back over the centuries. It is estimated that between 1920 and 1970, 30,000 Irish men and women answered the call of God to ‘go teach all nations the Good News’. Traditionally missionary work was a one-way service. Irish missionaries went overseas to serve. Times have changed in Ireland; vocations have declined. Other countries that once were mission territory are now sending missionaries.

Today we remember and pray for our missionaries. We support our missions financially. This weekend, every single parish worldwide will be remembering missionaries and each parish will give what they can. The money taken up in the collections will support overseas missionaries, many of whom work in the world’s most impoverished communities. World Missions Ireland, the Church charity for overseas missions, is responsible for coordinating Mission Month. Go to www.wmi.ie to learn more about their work.
