ST. BRIGID, 5TH CENTURY, ONE OF IRELAND'S PATRON SAINTS

There is a taste of spring about St. Brigid. She is the Celtic Goddess, turned Christian. She is Mary of the Gael. Green, riverside rushes are interwoven into her beautiful Brigid Cross. Its heart goes in four directions. For Brigid, all of life, the four corners of the earth, are interwoven with God's love in Jesus Christ. She is the saint of field and farm – the woman of hospitality. She is loved for her feminine qualities, choosing to take the veil (become a Religious Sister) when the 'done thing' was to get married, choosing the responsibility of a bishop with the blessing of St. Mel.
