Fr. Robert writes...

KINSALF CONFIRMATIONS 2020

Like so many other events in the parish, we were not able to celebrate Confirmation on the scheduled date of May 18^{th} , nor were we able to have the Ceremony of Light on May 11^{th} .

Now we are going to have three Confirmation ceremonies, one for each school in the parish. Because of public health guidelines on gatherings, only the young people making Confirmation and their parents can attend. Families and friends will be able to watch the ceremony on the parish webcam.

Confirmation celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit. In the Acts of the Apostles we see the apostles receiving the Holy Spirit. They had been hiding after the death of Jesus, but the coming of the Spirit gave them new courage to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ.

We were made members of God's family at Baptism. At Confirmation our Baptism is completed or 'sealed' by the Holy Spirit and we are called to be Christian witnesses just like the apostles.

Sponsors

A sponsor is a support person for the Confirmation candidate to give them encouragement and inspiration. Regrettably, the sponsors role will have to be fulfilled this year by proxy due to the public health restrictions on attendance.

Name

The tradition of taking a new name at Confirmation emphasises the new identity of the Christian being called to witness to our faith. People are encouraged to take a saint's name or a name from the Bible.

Oil

Oil of Chrism is a mixture of olive oil and balsam blessed by the Bishop.

I invite all our parishioners to pray for the young people being confirmed over the next week. May the Lord pour out His Spirit upon them. May they be an inspiration to us all.
