## MOMENTOUS OCCASION

Pope Francis has called what is known as an Extraordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. This will be attended by Bishops from all around the world. The first session of the Synod runs from 5<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> October. You may remember questionnaires being given out about a year ago seeking the views of parishioners on the issues facing families from a faith point of view.

Informed by the feedback from around the world, the Bishops will discuss issues such as divorce, contraception, same sex marriage etc. A big part of the discussion is going to be taken up with whether people in second marriages should be admitted to Sacraments.

This year's Synod will be confined to studying these issues. A second Synod in 12 months time will make decisions on the topics. Clearly these two Synods will be momentous occasions in the life of the Church. It will be very difficult to reach decisions on these complex topics. Not surprisingly, Pope Francis appeals to all Catholics to pray for the success of the Synod. He has provided a special prayer for families to say. Here is the final verse of the prayer:

*Holy Family of Nazareth,  
may the approaching Synod of Bishops  
make us once more mindful  
of the sacredness and inviolability of the family,  
and its beauty in God's plan.  
Jesus, Mary and Joseph,  
graciously hear our prayer. Amen*
