## FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY GOD IS WATCHING OVER US



It is impossible for us to understand God. God is mystery. However, to say that something is a mystery does not mean we cannot know anything about it. It means that we don't fully understand everything about it.

We would know very little about God were it not for the fact of God's self-revelation. It is through the Scriptures that we learn about God: God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

From the Scriptures we learn about the nature of God: creator, tender, compassionate, full of love, merciful. God is a God of love.

God loves us, not because we are good, but because God is good. The fact that we exist is because of the love of God. God's revelation is Jesus and The Holy Spirit.

When we try to follow God's way of loving and caring for all, especially the most vulnerable, we experience the peace of God. As St. Paul says, "*be united, live in peace, help one another and the God of love and peace will be with you*" [2 Cor 13.12]. Where love is, God is. The mystery of The Trinity is the mystery of love. It is worthwhile to remember that God is love and that He loves us unconditionally. This conviction gives us strength in times of weakness, comfort in sadness, hope in times of despair.
