## FAMILY LIFE: THE KEY INGREDIENT

No matter how carefully you bake a cake, it won't turn out right if you neglect a key ingredient. Family life, of course, is no piece of cake, it is demanding and challenging. What makes family life more difficult, I believe, is when a key ingredient is missing. This key ingredient has to do with the relationship of the family with our Creator.
