The death took place peacefully in Cramers Court Nursing Home, Belgooly, of **Joan McCarthy**, Rose Abbey, on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2018. Joan was a native of Kinsale. Her family suffered a terrible tragedy in 1942 when Joan was 8 years old. Her father was killed at sea when The Irish Pine ship was bombed by the German Army in World War 2. Two other Kinsale families; Sheehans and Connollys, were bereaved by the same incident. Joan worked locally and in the UK. Sadly she got a stroke over 20 years ago and was cared for in Cramers Court.

The funeral was celebrated by Fr. Robert and the burial was to The Abbey cemetery.

## 10 DIGITAL COMMANDMENTS

Pope Benedict described the internet as a new digital continent in 2009. Meeting with university students, we discussed how to be 'Digital Missionaries' in this new continent. We looked at different topics; digital discernment, digital navigation and how to avoid digital rocks. We all agreed we are on a deep learning curve. We all need to teach each other how to use these new technologies wisely. As a group we came up with 10 Digital Commandments:

- 1.** Thou shalt not text/comment when you are drunk. The internet doesn't forgive or forget.
- 2.** On the Sabbath day, thou shalt take rest from digital life (addiction is a real problem)
- 3.** Honour thy friend and ask permission before you tag.
- 4.** Thou shalt cut down on multi-tasking as this is junkfood for the brain. Web needs quality, not quantity.
- 5.** Thou shalt slow down, pause and not be reactive. Digital impulse control is important. There is enough hatred in the world already.
- 6.** Thou shalt not gamble or spend money online that you don't have.
- 7.** Thou shalt prioritise speaking to real friends. Social isolation and acute withdrawal is a real problem.
- 8.** Thou shalt avoid 'false intimacies'. When lonely, don't fill the void by going to 'dark places' online.
- 9.** Thou shalt be true to thyself, not having a false image and lifestyle in your digital life.
- 10.** Thou shalt be an online peacemaker. There is enough anger in the world, don't add to it with negative comments.
