*“Dear lay faithful, be close to your priests with affection
and with your prayers, that they may always be
shepherds according to God’s heart. And pray for those
whom God is calling to be priests that they may respond
to this call with humility and joy.”*

A Prayer for Priests

Lord Jesus, You have chosen your priests from among us and sent them
out to proclaim Your Word and to act in Your name. For so great a gift to
your Church we give You praise and thanksgiving. We ask You to fill
them with the fire of Your love, that their ministry may reveal Your
presence in the Church. Since they are earthen vessels, we pray that Your
power shine out through their weakness. In their afflictions let them
never be crushed; in their doubts, never despair; in temptation never be
destroyed; in persecution never abandoned. Inspire them through
prayer to live each day the mystery of Your dying and rising. In times of
weakness send them Your Spirit, and help them to praise Your heavenly
Father and pray for poor sinners. By the same Holy Spirit put Your
words on their lips and Your love in their hearts, to bring good news to
the poor and healing to the broken-hearted. And may the gift of Mary
Your mother, to the disciple whom You loved, be Your gift to every
priest. Grant that she who formed You in her human image, may by her
intercession, help to form them in Your divine image, by the power of the
Holy Spirit, to the glory of God the Father. Amen.
