Fr. Robert writes...

SPRING STATION 2021 – DIFFERENT!!



‘Stations’ are the gathering of neighbours in a locality.

Here in Kinsale parish, in some areas the gathering is in a family home, in other areas the gathering is in a central location. The most important thing about stations is the gathering of people who are neighbours. The Lord said, ‘when two or three gather in my name, I will be present among them’ Mt 8:20. Something special happens when we gather in faith. The station is about welcoming the Lord to our area, making a space for God in our lives. We draw strength from the Lord, as the psalm says, ‘those who draw their strength from God are strong indeed.’

Unfortunately, because of Covid-19, we cannot gather in the usual way for the station. Instead, the Station Mass will be live-streamed from the parish church. I invite the people in each area to join in your Station Mass from your home on the parish radio or on the parish webcam (www.kinsaleparish.org click on Live Church Streaming). The dates and times of the Station Masses are listed inside the Beacon and on the parish website (www.kinsaleparish.org). A Mass leaflet will be delivered to each home. We all need to have hope to keep going in the face of the many challenges of the Covid-19 pandemic. The hope that Jesus offers spreads from Him through others. We can see signs of hope when we live in solidarity with one another. Jesus gives courage.

I invite each family to join the Station Mass for your area. You might like to create a sacred space in your home to welcome the Lord and ask His help. Create your own Altar, use a white cloth, candle, crucifix, statue, flowers. This is an act of faith, that you are placing your trust in Him and welcoming Him to your homes and locality.

May Our Lady, Mother of Divine love, ask her Son to protect all the people of our community and give us fresh hope so as to persevere through these challenging times.
